GENERAL INFORMATION:

Beginning in August, the MSD of Martinsville will continue a 2-hour delay schedule on Wednesdays for the 2023-2024 school year. Students will arrive two hours late every Wednesday to provide teachers with time for collaboration with Professional Learning Communities.

The ultimate goal of WELL WEDNESDAYS is to positively impact student achievement.

(1) Improve student performance and outcomes.

(2) Offer flexibility in the administration of educational programs and improve the efficiency of school operations.

CHILDCARE:

Morgan County's YMCA and the Martinsville School District will continue to partner to provide before and after school programs. These programs provide adult supervision, homework help, activities, and snacks. Again this year, the YMCA is extending its services on Wednesday mornings from 6:30 A.M., to the delayed start of the school day.

The regular weekly schedule for before and after school care will not change. It will still be starting at 6:30 A.M., each day. For families who will utilize this program all week, the fee is \$70 each week per student and includes the extended WELL Wednesday hours.

For families who are interested in utilizing the YMCA's before school program ONLY on WELL Wednesdays, the fee will be \$35 per student.

- Select the buses you want to follow. Search the number and school. School abbreviations are listed on the right side of this page. (Example: 10-GTE-AM)
- Create Alert Zones which contact you when the bus enters it. Multiple Zones can be entered.
- 6. Enable Push Notifications under settings to receive messages about the bus route.






