




TITLE I



NEW Dismissal Plan for Snowman Social

Dismissal will begin at 4:15

Staff members will be outside directing traffic. Once Smith Elementary is done with dismissal, BIA staff will remove the stop sign and will allow two rows of vehicles to move forward to the back of the building. Staff Members will ask for your student's name and will radio into the building for him or her to dismiss. Once all cars are loaded along the back of the building, an officer will dismiss vehicles one lane at a time. A new group of vehicles will pull forward and we will repeat the process.
