Since Martinsville is pursuing a high quality rating, we are able to offer **FREE** Title I Pre-K and **FREE** On My Way Pre-K tuition vouchers for qualifying families. We will also be offering **REDUCED RATE** scholarships to the remaining families that claim their spots! Priority will be given to children of MSD Martinsville staff and families with current students. All other enrollments will be honored on a first-come, first- served basis. The State requires a 12:1 student to staff ratio. Full or half day classes will be determined by the number of applications.

THINGS TO BRING ON MARCH 28th:

- A recent utility bill (must be within the last 60 days)
- The lowest pay stub for each parent working within the last 60 days
- If not working, but enrolled in school, need a current school schedule
