The Body Safety Program will be presented to the 7th grade on Oct. 8 and to the 8th grade on Oct. 10.

Based on the latest research and reviewed and endorsed by national experts, the program empowers children to spot and respond to bullying, cyberbullying, child abuse, and digital dangers. Most importantly, it teaches that adults are responsible for kids' safety, but there are also things kids can do to help adults keep them safe.
