#### **JRW Baseball Tryouts**

Date: First or Second Week in March
Time: 2 hours (3pm-5pm)
Location: Outside, Martinsville High School Baseball Field



#### What to Bring:

- All necessary equipment
  - Glove
  - Bat
  - Helmet
  - Catchers Equipment (if you are a catcher)
  - Long Sleeves/Sweatshirt
  - Baseball pants
  - Cleats/Turf Shoes
  - Water Bottle
  - Hat

#### **Transportation:**

• Students are expected to arrive at MHS immediately after school lets out at JRW. They can be driven by a parent or guardian, or they may take their bus to the high school. Students who do not typically ride a bus, can ride bus 50 to the high school. Bus 50 picks up at door 10, at Wooden, shortly after the other buses depart. We will meet as a team, by the football gates no later than 3:00 pm. Students should be dressed and ready to go by that time.

#### **Expectations:**

- All tryouts and practices will be closed to all parents/spectators. No exceptions!
- Students must have a physical on file and all Final Forms paperwork must be completed prior to the first tryout date
- Students who met the grade requirements should attend all tryout dates, unless previously discussed with Coach Bunton
- Students should be dressed and equipped properly to tryout
- Parents should make arrangements for students to be picked up no later than
   5:15 from the "circle" at the back of MHS
- Students should give their best effort, be a teamplayer, and have a great attitude! A spot on the roster is always earned and never guaranteed!
