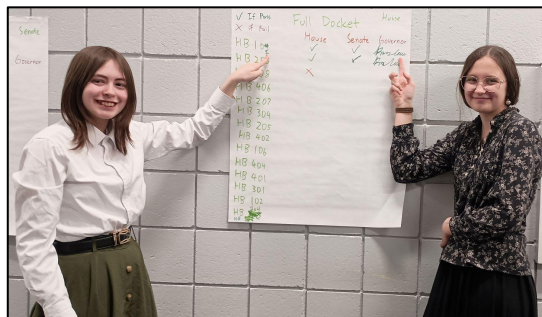

JRW Youth and Leadership students have great success in mock conference

On Sunday, Dec. 7, three JRW Youth and Leadership Club members (Sophia Ennis, Violet Leitzman, and Kiyah Orr) participated in a mock legislature. The students wrote their own bills that they believe would make good laws. They presented and debated their bills in committee. If their bills ranked high enough, they had the opportunity to present and debate their bills before the entire House of Representatives. If the other representatives voted to pass their bill, it moved to the Senate where it was presented and debated there. If it passed the Senate, it was read by the governor, and he decided whether or not to sign it into law.

For the first time in three years, one of our bills was passed into law! It was Sophia and Violet's bill regarding contamination of the White River. It also won the Outstanding Bill Award, which was based on nominations from the adults and advisors present.
